## Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in Benewah Community Hospital's Registered Nurse (RN) Tuition Scholarship and Stipend Program. BCH is excited to offer scholarships to individuals within our community!

The goal of this program is to provide educational growth as well as the opportunity to work as a healthcare professional in our community. We understand that a lot of individuals have difficulty affording living expenses while they are attending school full-time. Scholarship recipients will be required to work a limited number of hours at BCH (minimum of 1 (12-hour) hospital shift a week, or 2 (8-hour) clinic shifts a week, and will receive an educational stipend for "work-study hours." Total work-study hours and actual worked hours will be equivalent to 36 total compensable hours per week. BCH will pay tuition expenses to North Idaho College (NIC) for each student, and the student is responsible for testing fees, such as the RN entrance exam, NCLEX exam, etc.

NIC's current, approximate tuition cost for their RN program:

Semester 1: 18 Credits (pre-requisites) - \$3,470	Semester 4: 13 credits - \$2,645
Semester 2: 14 credits - \$2,800	Semester 5: 11 credits - \$2,315
Semester 3: 14 credits - \$2,800	TUITION TOTAL: \$14,030

CNA – RN: Must complete semesters 1-5; LPN – RN: Must complete semesters 4-5.

### Education requirements:

- Grades must be kept above a 3.0/B cumulative GPA
- Individual class grades must be kept at or above a 2.0/C
- If an individual is not accepted into the RN program right away or is waitlisted, the CNA/LPN will work full-time without the stipend until accepted into the RN program (minimum, 36-hours per week).
- The stipend will be suspended when the student is not attending classes, and the student will work full-time during summer break (minimum, 36-hours per week).

For current BCH employees: Scholarship recipients will maintain their benefit status, to include health insurance, retirement, Paid Time Off (PTO) and Extended Illness Bank (EIB). PTO and EIB will only accrue on actual hours worked, not work-study hours.

For those not currently employed by BCH: Once hired (subject to new hire screenings such as background and drug testing), as an employee at BCH (no later than June 2025), scholarship recipients will be eligible for benefits, such as health insurance, retirement, PTO, and EIB, after successful completion of initial introductory period as outlined in BCH policy. Once eligible for benefits, PTO and EIB will only accrue on actual hours worked, not work-study hours.

\*Individuals who have a written warning on file, or a disciplinary probation or suspension at current facility are not eligible to apply.

Scholarship recipients are required to enter into a contract with BCH to include commitment following receipt of RN license (CNA – LPN: 5 years, LPN – RN: 2-years). If recipient chooses to leave BCH prior to contract commitment, a prorated portion of tuition and stipend costs to be paid back to BCH (outlined in contract).
